



## Motorcoach/School Bus Guide

Thank you for bringing your group to the Pittsburgh CLO!  
Below are a few tips and suggestions to help guide your drive into Downtown Pittsburgh.

- We encourage your driver to stay with the motorcoach/bus during the performance with engines turned off. Engines may not idle for more than 5 minutes, in accordance with Allegheny County Health Department Rules and Regulations, Article XXI - Air Pollution Control, §2105.91 “School Bus Idling”.
- Parking is permitted on Fort Duquesne Blvd. but the driver must stay with the vehicle at all times. However, please always check with front of house staff at each theater for up to date parking information as parking availability may change due to other events in the Downtown area (i.e., football games, baseball games, conventions, construction, etc). Parking variances may also have been obtained by Hall Management if a large quantity of motorcoaches/buses are expected. Please inquire with theater staff at the time of the performance if such variances are available.
- For weekday matinees, traffic authorities may be present to direct motorcoaches/buses to parking locations throughout the Cultural District.
- If the driver is attending the performance, there are several open air lots available within a 10-15 minute walk. PNC Park & Heinz Field on the North Shore, Courtyard Marriot Hotel by the David L. Lawrence Convention Center (reservations may be required as space is limited), and across the street from Heinz History Center on Smallman Street in the Strip District. Parking arrangements for the open air lots are the responsibility of the individual group.
- Please ask members of your group to be prepared for inclement weather. Dropping off directly in front of the theater is prohibited unless you are a senior or special needs group. These groups are permitted to drop off and pick up in front of the theater, if traffic permits. When picking up after the performance, the motorcoaches/buses may not pull up in front of the theater until 10-15 minutes after the show concludes due to heavy pedestrian traffic.
- Please allow extra time prior to arrival as Downtown is often congested with daily traffic.
- **PARKING IS NOT PERMITTED IN FRONT OF ANY THEATER IN THE CULTURAL DISTRICT.**
